**TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION FOR THE 38TH AVENUE PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE COUNT GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000**

**WHEREAS**, the City has adopted the 38<sup>th</sup> Avenue Corridor Plan and invested in roadway improvements to revitalize the corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to monitor the impacts of the roadway improvements, including the number of pedestrians and bicyclists using the street; and


**WHEREAS**, the City has secured a grant from Jefferson County Public Health to hire a consultant to perform pedestrian and bicycle counts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wheat Ridge Charter requires that amendments to the budget be effected by the City Council adopting a Resolution.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, as follows:

- A. The City Council authorizes the acceptance of the 38<sup>th</sup> Avenue Pedestrian/Bicycle Count Grant in the amount of \$2,000 and a corresponding increase in General Fund revenues.
- B. The City Council authorizes the transfer of \$2,000 from the General Fund undesignated reserves to account number #01-120-700-750 and amending the 2012 fiscal year budget accordingly.
