TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 CAPITAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (CIP) BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$121,312.18 TO FUND THE TABOR STREET PROPERTY ACQUISITION SERVICES FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO H.C. PECK & ASSOCIATES, INC.

WHEREAS, the City supports the construction of the Gold Line Commuter Rail Corridor; and

WHEREAS, the City has selected, by an established process, a consultant to perform the property acquisition for the Tabor Street Multi-modal Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a federal grant by the Federal Transportation Authority through Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG) and the Regional Transportation District (RTD) to provide the construction of this particular street segment; and

WHEREAS, said amount be transferred from the CIP fund balance to the Gold Line station street project account to finance the project cost, and the City will seek reimbursement from RTD upon project completion; and

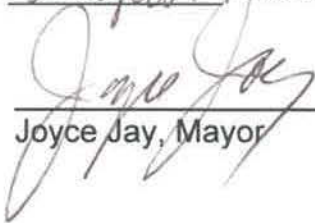
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, that:

Section 1. Budget Amended. The City of Wheat Ridge fiscal year 2014 CIP Budget be amended by transferring an amount of \$121,312.18 from CIP Fund undesignated reserves to line item 30-303-800-860 for the Gold Line station street project.

Section 2. Project Awarded. The Tabor Street Property Acquisition Services for Reconstruction is awarded to H.C. Peck & Associates in an amount not-to-exceed \$121,312.18.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
