**TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,000 FOR SPECIFIC CODE ENFORCEMENT STRATEGIES**

**WHEREAS**, the Wheat Ridge Charter requires that amendments to the budget be effected by the City Council adopting a resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wheat Ridge City Council identified code enforcement as an action agenda item during the 2014 City Council retreat; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wheat Ridge City Council recognizes the important role that proactive code enforcement plays in achieving the goals of the City, and that the City's code enforcement strategies should be strengthened; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department is increasing two (2) non-benefited temporary Community Services Officers from seasonal 26-week employment to annual 52-week employment to work on specific code enforcement strategies to address residential and commercial nuisance code enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of the increase to the Community Services Officers Staff Salary and Wages Budget account is \$27,000 and the cost for a vehicle for the Community Services Team is \$35,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Wheat Ridge City Council, that:

Section 1. Effectiveness. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes transferring \$62,000 from General Fund undesignated reserves to the following accounts,

01-203-600-617      \$27,000

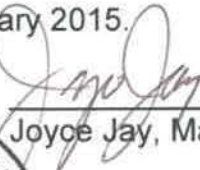
01-303-800-807      \$35,000

And amending the 2015 General Fund revenues accordingly.
