TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENT BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$48,000 FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY TRAINING FOR EIGHT WHEAT RIDGE RECRUITS

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen retirements, resignations, and separations from the police department, as well as anticipating possible retirements, resignations, and separations through the end of 2018, the police department is requesting additional funding to send eight Wheat Ridge Police recruits to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office and Lakewood Police Department's Combined Regional Academy; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the increase to the Police Department Training Budget account is \$6,000 per recruit for eight recruits; and

WHEREAS, the Wheat Ridge Charter requires that amendments to the budget be effected by the City Council adopting a resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, as follows:


Section 1. A transfer of \$48,000 from General Fund undesignated reserves for police recruit training costs for eight police recruits to account 01-207-700-728 is hereby approved and revenues are amended accordingly.
