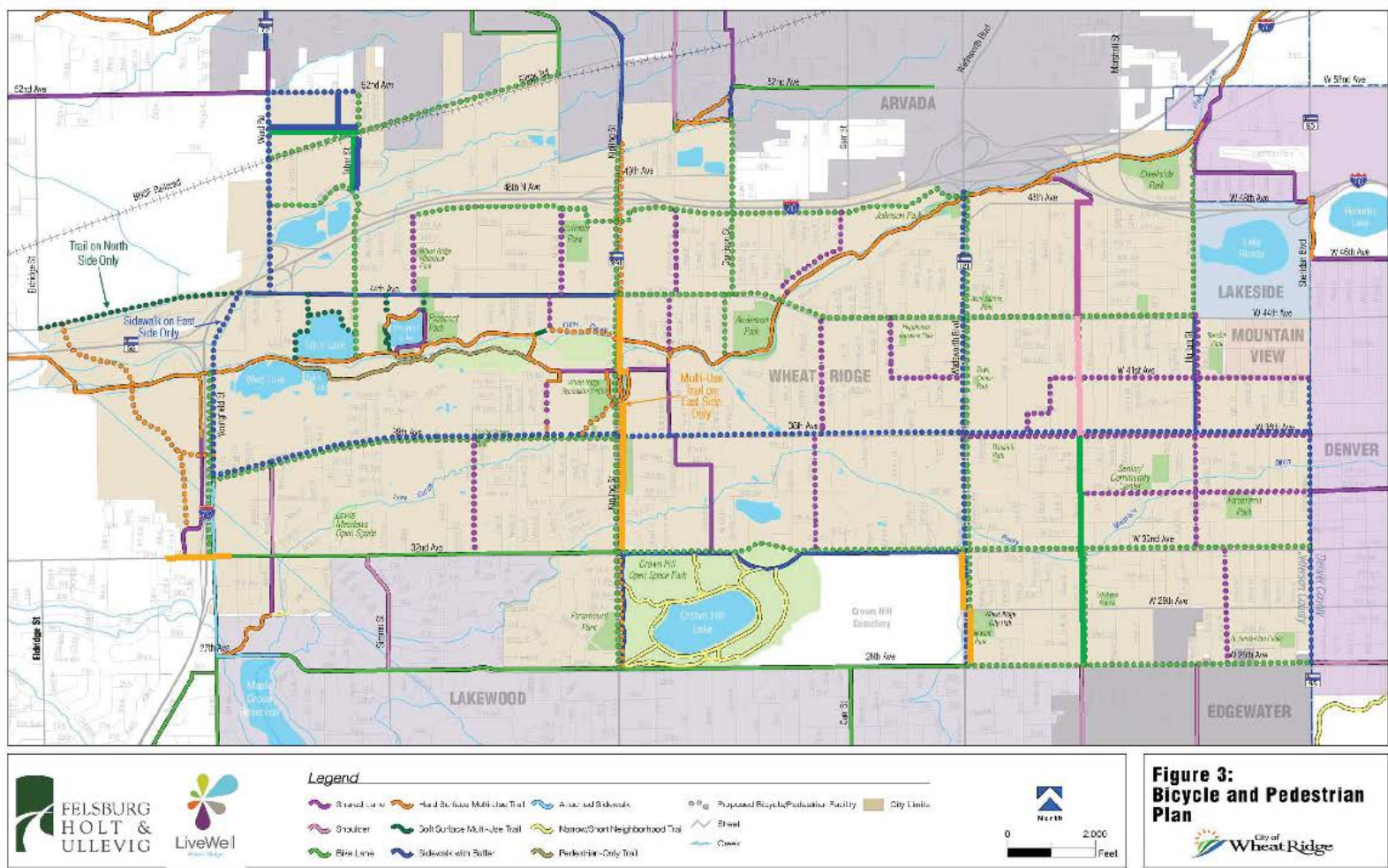
Bicycle Facilities History

- Public Process
 - Comprehensive Plan -Envision Wheat Ridge (2009)
 - Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan (2010)
 - Address Multi-Modal Transportation Needs (Bicycle, Pedestrian, Transit, & Auto)
 - Connections to Schools, Neighborhoods, Businesses, Parks, & Adjacent Communities
 - Community Partners
 - City of Wheat Ridge
 - LiveWell Wheat Ridge
 - Jefferson County Public Health and Transportation Departments
 - Community Stakeholders

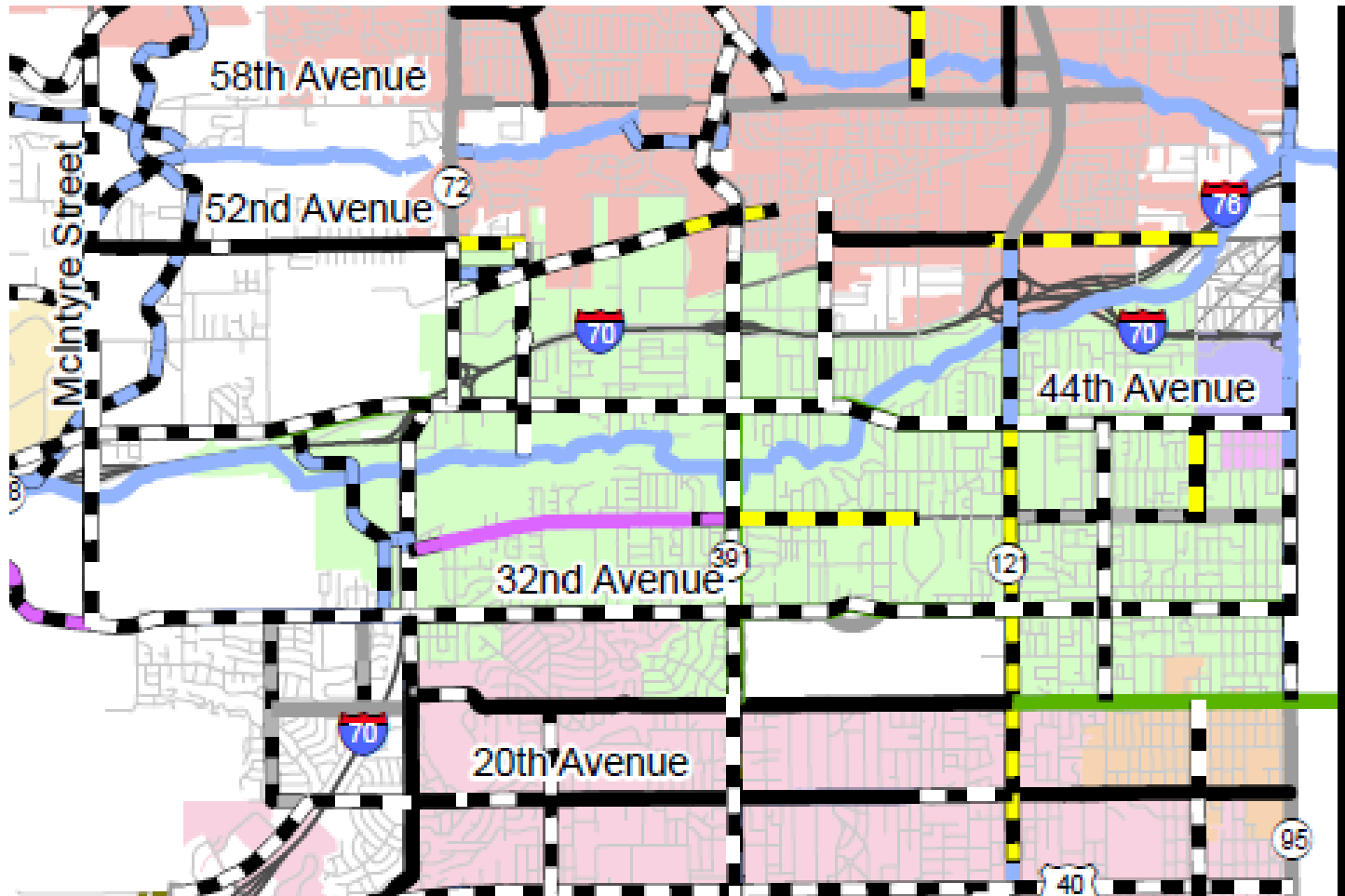
Why 32nd?

- Bike/Ped Master Master Plan
 - #2 Priority East-West Route
- Connectivity
 - Schools, churches, & Crown Hill Open Space Park
 - Pierce Street Bike Lanes & Kipling & Wadsworth Trails
 - Adjacent communities
- Feasibility
 - Overlay scheduled this year with adequate pavement width to add bike lanes

Jefferson County Bicycle Plan

Legend

- Bicycle Route - Roadways signed or not signed for the shared use of automobiles and bicyclists without striping or pavement markings.
- Proposed Sidewalk
- Sidewalk - A hard surface path between four and eight feet in width for use by bicyclists and pedestrians and is physically separated from motor vehicle traffic on at least one side of the street.
- Proposed Paved Shoulder
- Paved Shoulder - A paved shoulder of at least four feet in width.
- Proposed Bicycle Lanes
- Bicycle Lane - A portion of a paved roadway at least four feet in width that has been designated for the exclusive use of bicycles.

- Proposed Shared Use Path
- Shared Use Path - A hard surface path at least eight feet in width for use by bicyclists and pedestrians and is physically separated from motor vehicle traffic on at least one side of the street.
- Proposed Facility - Comprised of a combination of Bicycle Lanes, Paved Shoulders, or a widened outside lane where feasible.
- Loose Surface Trail
- Roads

Note: Intent of plan is to depict existing or proposed on-street bicycle facilities or separate shared-use paths. Many arterial streets have attached sidewalks that are also available for use by bicyclists and pedestrians.

Project Goals

- Improve bicycle facilities on 32nd Avenue
 - 3 to 6 foot wide bike lanes
- Traffic Calming
 - 10 foot wide travel lanes
- Scope of Improvements
 - East 1 ½ Mile
 - Restripe to add bike lanes with symbols & signs
 - Middle 1 ½ Mile
 - Widen & restripe to add narrow bike lanes with symbols & signs
 - West 1 ½ Mile
 - Add symbols & signs

Completed Schedule

- 2014 – Project added to 2015 Budget
- March 2 – City Council Study Session
 - Staff directed to implement this project and others
- April 1 – Neighborhood Meeting
 - Invitations sent to adjacent properties only
 - Obtain input from potentially impacted properties

Next Steps

- March 30 – Out to bid
 - Included in Annual Street Maintenance Project
 - Quantities for bike lanes, symbols, & signs
- April 14 – Bid Opening
 - Staff will evaluate pricing vs budget
- April 27 – City Council Meeting
 - Council will decide which projects to pursue
